**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all musicians born, residing or studying in the state of Colorado as of September 1, 2009. Applicants must be no older than 22 as of April 1, 2010.

**APPLICATIONS:** Must be completed and returned with proof of age, brief biography and a check for \$40 (non-refundable entry fee) made payable to the Boulder Philharmonic Orchestra, postmarked by November 9, 2009. A confirmation will be mailed upon receipt of the application.

**REPERTOIRE CRITERIA:** One movement of a concerto or concert piece for solo instrument or voice and orchestra. Selection must be memorized.

**AUDITIONS:** Auditions will be held on Saturday, December 5, 2009 (9am-5pm) at the Parlano School for the Arts at the Dairy Center for the Arts, 26th and Walnut Streets in Boulder, Colorado. Accompanists must be provided by the applicant. Decisions made by judges and competition committee are final. All auditions are closed to the public.

**WINNERS:** Three winners (first, second and third place) will be chosen. The first place winner will receive \$500.

About the Boulder Philharmonic Orchestra

The Boulder Philharmonic Orchestra was founded in 1958. Each season the orchestra features great masterpieces, exciting new works and prominent guest artists, including Itzhak Perlman, Yo-Yo Ma, Jessye Norman, James Galway, Frederica Von Stade, Sarah Chang and many others. The Boulder Philharmonic Orchestra also has a strong commitment to education. Individual members teach classes through the Boulder Arts Academy and, through the Partners in Education program, musicians perform Classroom Concerts that reach over 5,000 Boulder Valley school children each year.

Music Director Michael Buttermen began his tenure as Music Director for the Boulder Philharmonic in the 2006-2007 Season. Mr. Buttermen gained international attention as a diploma laureate in the Prokofiev International Conducting Competition and as a finalist in the prestigious Besançon International Conducting Competition. As the 1999 recipient of the Seiji Ozawa Fellowship, he studied at Tanglewood with Robert Spano, Jorma Panula, and Maestro Ozawa, and shared the podium with Ozawa to lead the season's opening concert. In 1997, Mr. Buttermen was sponsored by UNESCO to lead the National Philharmonic Orchestra of Moldova in a concert of music from great American masters.
