BOULDER, Colo., (January 11, 2010) – Celebrating a season of musical masterpieces, the [Boulder Philharmonic Orchestra](#) takes the stage on Saturday evening, January 23, 2010, at CU's Macky Auditorium, 7:30 p.m. for a concert featuring the three B's— Bach, Beethoven & Brahms— and welcomes back the award-winning pianist and Boulder native, Christopher Taylor.

"Bach, Beethoven, and Brahms form a musical Mt. Rushmore," said [Michael Buttermann](#), the Phil's music director, "and the music they created has resonated across time and across cultures like almost nothing else."

This interconnected program, which focuses on the use of the motive, flows chronologically and opens with Bach's, *Brandenburg Concerto No. 3*, continues with Beethoven's monumental *Symphony No. 5*, and closes with Brahms breathtaking *Piano Concerto No. 1*, a masterpiece highlighting both piano and orchestra as equal partners, featuring, [Christopher Taylor](#), as soloist.
