### **Boulder Phil Chamber Players Kick Off “Music with a View” Concert Series at the Arvada Center**

*Concert features Phil music director Michael Buttermann,  
violinist and wife Jennifer Carsillo, and cellist Charles Lee*

Boulder Philharmonic Chamber Players kick off the fall season of the “Music with a View” concert series at the Arvada Center with the Phil’s music director Michael Buttermann at the piano joined by violinist Jennifer Carsillo and principal cellist Charles Lee for an engaging program of duos and trios at the Arvada Center, September 24, 2009, at 7:00 p.m. The concert is preceded by an ArtTalk/ArtTour at 6:15 p.m.

The husband-and-wife team of Buttermann and Carsillo will present music of Fritz Kreisler and a lovely new work by composer Kevin Puts, while Lee and Carsillo perform Ravel’s well-loved Sonata for Violin and Cello. Along with music by Rachmaninoff and Arvo Pärt, the trio closes the program with two works by Argentinean tango master Astor Piazzolla.

The Boulder Phil performed three orchestra concerts this summer at the Arvada Center, with programs featuring Rodgers & Hammerstein favorites, patriotic music, and the music of Frank Sinatra. Expanding its relationship with the Arvada Center, the Boulder Philharmonic Chamber Players will present four concerts during the fall/winter season as part of the center’s “Music with a View” series. In addition to the September appearance, the players can be heard on December 17 performing “Holiday Jazz,” on February 25 performing music of Mendelssohn, and on April 8 for a varied program of Mozart, Poulenc, and Villa Lobos.

“Performing at the Arvada Center is a great way to enrich our season and extend the Boulder Phil’s reach beyond Boulder County,” said Michael Buttermann, music director for the Boulder Phil. “Our summer concerts were extremely well received, and we look forward to developing additional opportunities to perform at this wonderful performing arts complex.”
